## 1. Title of the Activity/Event/Practice

Conduction of B certificate examination.

## 2. Objectives of the Practice

### 3. The Context

8 Mah Girl Bn conducted B certificate examinations for NCC second year cadets in Sonopant Dandekar College.

### 4. The Practice:

The B certificate examinations of the National Cadet Corps is an important assessment that determine the level of proficiency and skill of cadets in various aspects of NCC training.

On 13<sup>th</sup> February, written exam for the same was conducted.

Along with the Commanding officer and Adm officer, ANOs of Boys and Girls units respectively Maj. B.K. Sakhare and Lt. AnaghaPadhye-Deshmukh, GCI Bhaswati Chaudhuri, PI and civil staff of 8 Mah Girls Bn were present during the examination.
