### **Report on C certificate examination.**

#### **1. Title of the Activity/Event/Practice**

Conduction of C certificate examination.

#### **2. Objectives of the Practice**

1. To assess the cadets' knowledge and understanding of various subjects related to the NCC, including drill, weapon training, map reading, and military tactics.
2. To evaluate the cadets' physical fitness and readiness to participate in NCC activities.
3. To encourage the cadets to develop leadership skills, self-discipline, and a sense of responsibility.
4. To motivate the cadets to continue their involvement in the NCC and to advance to higher levels of certification.
5. To provide recognition and rewards for the cadets who demonstrate proficiency and dedication in their NCC training.
6. To maintain the standards of the NCC and ensure that its cadets are well-prepared to serve their country in various capacities.

#### **3. The Context**

8 Mah Girl Bn conducted C certificate examinations for NCC third-year cadets in Sonopant Dandekar College.

#### **4. The Practice:**

The C certificate examinations of the National Cadet Corps is an important assessment that determines the level of proficiency and skill of cadets in various aspects of NCC training.

For the year 2021-22, C certificate exam has been conducted in S.D. College, Palghar. Commanding Officer of 8 Mah Girls Bn Col. M.L. Sharma and Adm Officer Maj. During the examination, cadets have been tested on various criteria for practical exams. The practical exams were conducted for Drill, Map Reading, and Weapon Training by staff of 8 Mah Girls Bn on 26<sup>th</sup> February 22.

On 27<sup>th</sup> February, a written exam for the same was conducted.

Along with the Commanding officer and Adm officer, ANOs of Boys and Girls units respectively Maj. B.K. Sakhare and Lt. Anagha Padhye-Deshmukh, GCI Bhaswati Chaudhuri, PI and civil staff of 8 Mah Girls Bn were present during the examination.

Girls and Boys cadets from nearby colleges having NCC, like colleges from Chinchani, Bordi were present for the exam.
