Name of the Event – Online Guest Lecture on “Different Types of Research Methods for the Formulation of Dissertation”

Date – 27/05/2023

About the Event – The webinar was delivered by Dr. Rohidas Munde, Asst. Prof., Department of Civics and Politics, University of Mumbai on the topic of ‘Different Types of Research Methods for the Formulation of Dissertation’. The honorable guest guided the students in detail on writing dissertation. Asst. Prof. Rutuja Raut was the host for the program. Prof. Dr. Tanaji J. Pol, Head, Department of Politics gave the presidential address for the webinar. Finally with the vote of thanks Asst. Prof. Madhura Raut concluded the program.

Event Objectives –

- **Promoting critical thinking and academic writing:** To empower students with the knowledge and tools necessary to make informed decisions regarding the selection and application of research methods in their own dissertations.
- **Exposure to types of research methods:** To introduce students to the various research methods available for formulating a dissertation along with an overview of qualitative research methods and their application in dissertation research as well as quantitative research methods and their relevance in the formulation of a dissertation. It shall also discuss mixed-methods research approaches and their potential benefits in dissertation projects.
- **Guiding on Dissertation:** To examine the process of selecting and justifying research methods for a dissertation project as well as discuss the strengths and limitations of different research methods and their impact on the quality of dissertation research.
- **Guiding on process of dissertation:** To provide a basic framework of overall process of formulation of dissertation right from choosing the research topic, choosing the appropriate research methods based on the research questions and objectives of a dissertation etc. It shall also address common challenges and ethical considerations associated with various research methods in dissertation research.

Learning Outcomes –

- **Understanding the importance of research methods:** It helped students to gain a clear understanding of the significance of research methods in the formulation of a dissertation and their impact on the overall quality of the research.
- **Familiarity with quantitative and qualitative research methods:** Students were exposed to different quantitative research methods, including surveys, experiments, and statistical analysis along with qualitative research methods, such as interviews, focus groups, and ethnography. It also helped them in understanding of when and how to apply these methods in the context of their dissertation.
- **Understanding mixed methods research:** Students could explore the concept of mixed methods research, which combines both quantitative and qualitative approaches. They learned when and how to integrate different methods to make their research unique.
- **Ethical considerations in research:** It also guided the students on the ethical considerations associated with different research methods, including informed consent, privacy, and confidentiality. They learnt how to navigate these ethical issues in their dissertation.
- **Enhancing research skills:** Students were guided with research skills, including data collection, analysis, and interpretation. The students also found it helpful when the guest provided in his lecture an easy to comprehend examples of survey, research questions etc.
