The main objective of the SFDC is to conduct training programmes for the newly inducted and in-service faculty in the institutions of Higher Education. Training Programmes under PMMMNMTT aim to develop four possible types of skills among teachers – personal (interpersonal skills, career development, and life planning issues); instructional (course design and development, instructional technology); organisational (ways to improve the institutional environment to better support teaching) and professional (ways to support faculty members so that they fulfil their multiple roles of teaching, research, and service). The development of these skill sets among the teachers of affiliated colleges is necessary to take up the challenges of syllabus revision and evaluations reforms.
