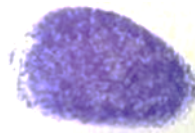

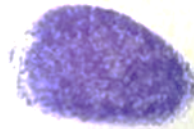



Brief description about the Event –

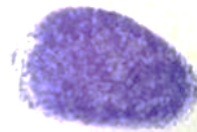
