
Introduction:

The employer's feedback is important as it ensures alignment of syllabus with industry needs, enhancing employability and helps to provide real-world experience to students.


This report summarizes the results of employer's feedback on syllabus to reduce the gap between industry and academics.

The curriculum of higher education adequately prepares students for the demands of the industry





The curriculum of higher education should be updated regularly to reflect changes in the industry






Soft skills, such as communication and teamwork, should be an integral part of the curriculum of higher education



Industry experts should be involved in the development of the curriculum for higher education







Question: 7 Collaboration between industry and higher education can bridge the gap between the two






Question: 10
