
#### **Introduction:**


This report summarizes the results of alumni feedback on syllabus to bring innovation by strengthening alumni relations.

**Question: 1**The curriculum adequately prepared me for my career





A higher education system with blended learning is vital. The shift from the traditional to the digital world is engaging and fruitful





Soft skills, such as communication, leadership skills, and teamwork, were effectively blended with my curriculum





**Question: 5**The curriculum requires a higher level of integration of practical and hands-on training





The curriculum had limited scope for industry-specific courses





The inclusion of online courses and blended learning provides an opportunity for higher integration of on-job training/part-time jobs





Participation in extension activities and project-based learning in the curriculum improves an individual's personality





The curriculum across all the courses should include project-based/internship mandatorily





Alumni should be part of the syllabus framing committee at affiliating body




