Report on Pulse Polio Program 2019-20

The event will take place at Sonopant Dandekar College. All NCC cadets are expected to attend and participate in the activity planned for the day. Objectives of the practice

- To create awareness among students and people.
- Routine immunization with oral polio vaccine
- Vaccination campaigns

The Context

In this program, children are provided with 2 doses of vaccine 4-6 weeks apart. There are around 17.4 crore children of less than five years of age across the country who all are provided with polio drops as a part of the drive of the Government of India in order to eradicate polio from the country.

The Practice

Sonopant Dandekar college extension services – NCC Successfully conducted Pulse Polio Immunization Program at Rural Hospital, Palghar. A total of 50 NCC cadets from Sonopant dandekar College alongside the hospital staff went door to door and gave polio drops to the children below the age of 5 years.
